Michael Charles Miskowski, age 68, of Lodi, California passed away on May 19, 2010. He was born to Nickolas and Angelina (Charles) Miskowski on January 6, 1942 in Easton, Pennsylvania. Following his high school graduation, he earned his AA Degree.

Michael entered the U.S. Navy in 1959 as an Missile Technician First Class on a submarine until he received his Honorable Discharge in 1968.

He moved to the Bay Area, and was employed at Lockheed Aero Space, later Lockheed Martin, where he worked as an engineer on the Hubble Space Telescope during his 31 years, before he retired in 1998. He and his family moved to Lodi in 2003.

Michael was a member of Grace Presbyterian Church in Lodi, enjoyed being with his family, and in the Bay Area he coached boys and girls soccer and baseball.

He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Kay Miskowski of Lodi; daughter and her husband, Michelle and Albert Santucci, and son and his wife, Scott and Kathy Miskowski; and five brothers and three sisters. Michael was known as Pappa to his five grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. Their oldest son, Eric Miskowski passed away in 1978.
