

## HARRY W. HART

Harry W. Hart, age 70, of Cromwell and formerly of Syracuse, Ind., passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, February 22, 2011, as the result of injuries in an automobile accident.

He was born on October 7, 1940, to Wesley and Wilhelamine (Strong) Hart in Norfolk, Neb. On June 7, 1969 he married Michele Miller.

Growing up in Omaha, Neb., he joined the United States Navy right after high school. He qualified in submarines on the USS Rock (SS-274) in 1965 and after 23 years in the Navy, most of those being in the submarine service, he retired as a MMCM/SS.

Harry was active in the United States Submarine Veterans and headed the local chapter called the Silversides Base.

Harry and his family moved to Syracuse, Ind., in 1982 and then to Cromwell, Ind., in 1989.

Surviving are his wife, Michele of Cromwell; a son, Jason Hart of Cromwell; a brother, John (Pat) Hart of Overland Park, Kan.; a sister, Patricia (Jerry) Jones of Cheyenne, Wyo.; three nieces; and three nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Nora Glenn.
