COOKEVILLE -- Funeral services for James Loyd Hyder Sr., 69, of Cookeville will be held Friday, Sept. 12, at 1 p.m. at First Cumberland Presbyterian Church. Burial with military honors will follow in Cookeville Cemetery. Family will receive friends Thursday, Sept. 11, from 4-8 p.m. and Friday, Sept. 12, from 11 a.m. until time of services at the church.

Mr. Hyder died Tuesday, Sept. 9, 2008, at Cookeville Regional Medical Center. He was born May 13, 1939, in Putnam County to the late J.T. Hyder and the late Mary Alice Brown McClain.

Mr. Hyder was a member of First Cumberland Presbyterian Church, Cookeville Masonic Lodge 266 F & AM and the Al Menah Temple.
