Qualified in submarines on the USS Rasher (SS-269) in 1961 and was a IC1(SS) when he left the Navy.

Walter A. Lewis, a 32 year resident of Minden, NV went to be with his Lord and Savior on Sept 4, 2015 at the age of 73. He is survived by his wife of 43 years Susan Lewis of Minden Nevada, his son David Allen Lewis and wife Krystal Lewis of Carson City, Nevada, his daughter Crystal Elizabeth Lewis of Talihina, Oklahoma, granddaughters Bridget, Kayla and Khloe also of Carson City, Nevada, son Walter Anderson Lewis of California, and numerous cousins in Oklahoma and Idaho.
