MOOK, DONALD GEORGE departed on eternal patrol on September 5, 2016 after a short battle with cancer. Donald was born in Port Arthur, TX on March 1, 1948. Don proudly served in the U.S. Navy for 28 years, retiring in 1993 as an EMCM. Achieving the rank of Master Chief was the highlight of his career. He served aboard numerous SSBN submarines and concluded his career on SSN submarines. Being a submariner was one of his proudest accomplishments. Don met the love of his life, Vickie, while serving as an instructor at the Nuclear Power Training Unit in Idaho Falls, ID. They met on Labor Day weekend and were married eight short weeks later on October 29, 1976. Don loved fishing, hunting and shooting. But most of all he loved his family and his brothers – other submarine veterans. He is survived by his wife, Vickie, daughter April Jeneen Hilton (Andy), son Ian Harrison (Chris) and grandchildren Lexi Mook, Harrison Hilton, LeAnn Nichole Duclos and Gregory Dwayne Fields. He was preceded in death by his parents, Edith Mae (Hickey) Mook and George Harrison Mook, and daughter Stormy Kay (Mook) Fields.
