The U.S. Navy has launched an investigation into the cause of the death of a Charlotte man.

Scott Eric Sharpe, a 1988 graduate of Charlotte Hight School, died Thursday while on duty at Kings Bay, GA. He was stocking a submarine with supplies for a sea journey when he collapsed, said his mother, Gerrie Rardeen.

“At first they said it was cardiac arrest, but an autopsy said he was fit and healthy,” Rardeen said.

Sharpe was stationed in Charleston, S.C., and joined the Navy in March 1988.

While he attended high school Sharpe participated in cross country and wrestling.

He is survived by his mother; his father, Jack Sharpe of Lansing; and his brother, J. Christopher, who is also in the Navy.
